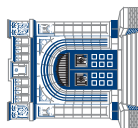

Being Faithful People in a Multi-Faith World

Dr. Cynthia M. Campbell is the ninth president of McCormick Theological Seminary. She has served as both a pastor to congregations and a seminary professor prior to coming to McCormick. In 1981, she became associate professor of theology and ministry and director of the doctor of ministry program at Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary. In 1988, Dr. Campbell became pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Salina, Kansas, one of the first large Presbyterian congregations to call a woman as head of staff.

Within the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), Cynthia has served on numerous task forces and committees such as the Special Committee of fifteen which prepared the final text for the Brief Statement of Faith (1990). She also represented the PCUSA on the theological commission of the Consultation on Church Union (COCU) and chaired the General Assembly special committee on COCU.

She is author of *A Multitude of Blessings: A Christian Approach to Religious Diversity* (Westminster John Knox, 2007) as well as a monograph, *Theologies Written from Feminist Perspectives*, published by the PCUSA. She has also written articles on theology, ministry, ethics and worship for several publications.

Dr. Campbell's topic for our lectures, "Being Faithful People in a Multi-Faith World: Implications of Religious Diversity for Christian Discipleship," addresses Christian ministry and witness in 21st century pluralistic cultures.
