Upcoming Projects



Finish Outdoor Worship Space

Our new outdoor worship space will be completed in 2026. Several volunteer groups have worked on the project by clearing the space in the trees, digging trenches and installing the cement block benches. To finish the project, a stage, cross, fire pit and landscaping needs to be completed. This space will provide additional outdoor gathering and worship opportunities that are accessible, shaded and exposed to nature.

Renovate Dining Hall Bathrooms

This project, actually completed in the first quarter of 2026, updates and refreshes the bathrooms in the Huxtable Dining Hall. These bathrooms are used by numerous guests and groups and still had the original countertop from the remodel/expansion of the Dining Hall in the late 80s. Maintaining the facilities is an on-going challenge with over 30 separate buildings dotting the 250 acre property.



Plan for Indoor Recreation

Indoor Recreation Space (think gym) has been talked about for years as a way of being attractive to groups throughout the year. The Board of Directors is working hard to determine the need, the scope and the cost of this project along with how to successfully raise funds to ensure it happens.
